We are pleased to announce that construction of **Bosco Farm Neighborhood Park** is expected to begin in early April 2010. As construction gets under way, we would like to let you know what to expect.

#### **WHO**

Clark County Public Works and Vancouver-Clark Parks and Recreation planned and designed this park project. The county has awarded the construction contract to Larry O. Collins, Inc. of Vancouver, WA.

#### **WHAT**

Bosco Farm Neighborhood Park is located on the east side of NE St. Johns Road between NE Petticoat Lane and NE 39th Street in the Truman neighborhood. Once complete, approximately five acres on the northeast side of this 12-acre park will feature:

- Paved and soft-surface trails
- Irrigated open lawn play area
- Benches
- Playground equipment
- Two picnic tables
- Additional trees and landscaping

#### **WHEN**

Construction will start in early April and be complete this fall. The contractor is allowed to work seven days a week, between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m.

#### **WHY**

In 2005, voters in the unincorporated urban area of Clark County approved the Greater Clark Parks District to provide maintenance and operations funding for 35 new parks. The county is now developing these parks using dedicated funding provided through local real estate excise taxes and park impact fees.

#### **CONSTRUCTION INFORMATION**

- The park will be closed throughout construction to protect public safety.
- Construction equipment will be entering and exiting the work site using neighborhood roads. The contractor understands the importance of working and driving safely in this area. Residents should also be extra careful around the construction equipment.
- Neighbors should expect noise, vibration and dust during construction.

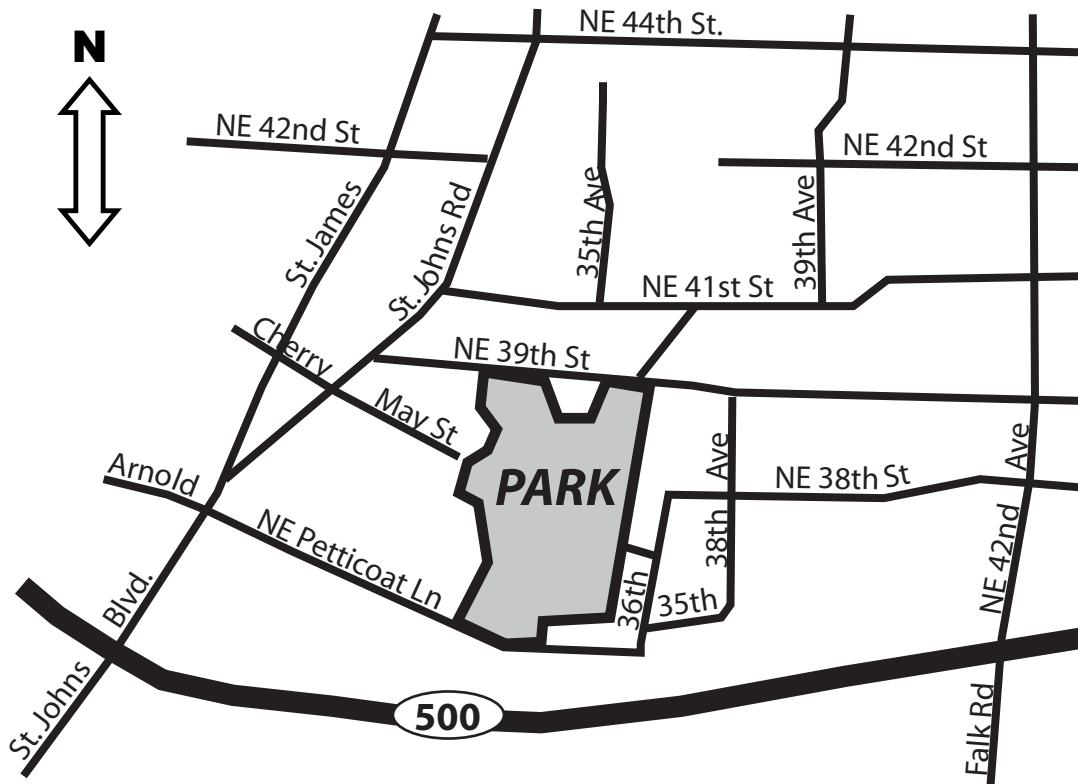
