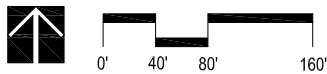


'ROUNDED' CONCEPT

KEY POINTS

- 6.0 ACRE PARK
- DEFINES WALKWAYS AWAY FROM EXISTING HOMES
- MORE TRADITIONAL NEIGHBORHOOD PARK
 - TRADITIONAL PLAY STRUCTURES
 - OPEN IRRIGATED (13,200 SF) AND NON-IRRIGATED (6500 SF) LAWN AREAS
 - ASPHALT WALKWAYS
- TRADITIONAL PLAY AREA -
 - PLAY STRUCTURES
 - SWINGS AND SLIDES
 - 'SPINNERS'
- PICNIC AREA ADJACENT TO THE PLAY AREA
- GREEN-WAY VIEWING AREA WITH BENCHES
- REQUIRED EMERGENCY VEHICLE TURN AROUND
- PRESERVES EXISTING GREEN SPACE AREAS
- ENHANCE NORTH ENTRANCE WITH NEW PLANTING

- VIEWING AREA WITH BENCHES
- UN-IRRIGATED LAWN AREA
- ASPHALT WALKING TRAILS
- LABYRINTH - HARDSCAPE
- NATURAL AREAS THAT PRESERVE EXISTING TREES AND VEGETATION
 - REMOVE HAZARD TREES
 - REMOVE INVASIVE PLANTS (BLACKBERRIES)
- PICNIC AREA (CLOSE TO PLAY AREA)
 - PICNIC TABLES
 - BENCHES
 - BIKE RACK
 - GARBAGE CAN
- TRADITIONAL PLAYGROUND
 - PLAY STRUCTURES
 - SWING SET
 - SLIDES
 - 'SPINNERS'
 - ETC...
- OPEN LAWN (IRRIGATED)
 - SOME TREE CLEARING TO OPEN LAWN AREA
- PLANTING AREAS WITH - INCORPORATING EXISTING TREES
- PARK ENTRANCE AREA
- REQUIRED EMERGENCY VEHICLE TURN AROUND
