We are pleased to announce that construction of phase one at **Fairgrounds Community Park** will begin in early to mid-May 2009. As construction gets under way, we would like to let you know about the schedule and related activities.

WHO

Clark County Public Works and Vancouver-Clark Parks and Recreation planned and designed this park development project. The county has awarded the construction contract to Colf Landscape Construction of Vancouver.

WHAT

Fairgrounds Community Park is located on Northwest 164th Street at Northwest Sixth Avenue on the southwest side of the Clark County Fairgrounds and Amphitheater. Phase one construction will add the following features to the east side of this 88-acre park:

- Walking, jogging and biking trail
- Two basketball half courts
- Irrigated open lawn play area
- Restroom and parking lot
- Playground
- Two covered picnic shelters with tables
- Landscaping and benches

The county will also widen the north side of Northwest 164th Street to include sidewalks and a bike lane in front of the park.

WHEN

Construction will start in May 2009 and is expected to be complete by summer 2010. The contractor may work Mondays through Saturdays from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m.

WHY

In 2005, voters in the unincorporated urban area of Clark County approved the Greater Clark Parks District, to provide maintenance and operations funding for 35 new parks. The county is now developing these parks, including Fairgrounds Community Park.

CONSTRUCTION INFORMATION

- The park site will be closed throughout construction. Construction equipment will be entering and exiting the work site using adjacent roads. The contractor understands the importance of working and driving safely in area. Residents should also be extra careful around the construction equipment.
- Neighbors should expect noise, vibration and dust from construction.
- Periodic, daytime single-lane closures and occasional full closures of 164th Street will be necessary in front of the park. Residential access will be allowed during any full closures.

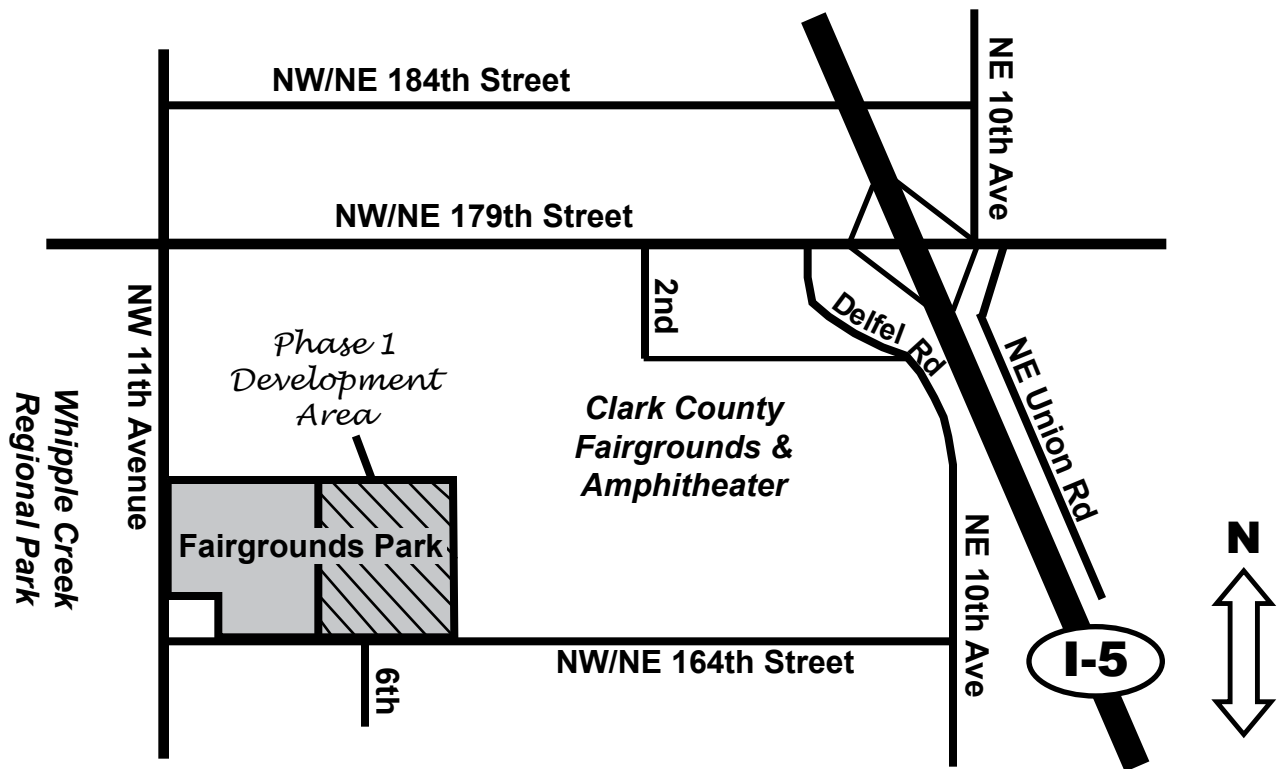
