

Lakeshore Neighborhood Park Update

Construction is scheduled to start at Lakeshore Neighborhood Park in a few months. The currently undeveloped park is located on Northwest 21st Avenue at 99th Street.

Clark County recently received a request to name the park in memory of Jack Fazio. The county is doing a survey to find out if neighbors support this request and we would like to hear from you.

Who was Jack Fazio?

Jack Fazio was born in Portland, Oregon in 1935. His father and uncle bought farmland along Lower River Road in Vancouver in the early 1950s, which the family still owns and operates.

In 1968, Jack and his three brothers purchased the Lakeshore property on the southwest corner of NW 99th Street and 21st Avenue. After selling a couple acres to the Mormon Church, Jack built a house on the corner where he and his wife, Anita, raised their two children.

Jack and his brother, Richard, then opened Fazio Brothers Sand Company on the family's farm property on Lower River Road in 1975. The company is still in operation and provides sand and trucking services throughout the area.

Jack was very happy when his family sold the property next to his home in Lakeshore to the county for use as a park. Unfortunately, Jack passed away in 2007, and did not get to see the park developed.
