# Help Take Pacific Community Park to New Heights!

In July 2008, construction was completed on the first phase of Pacific Community Park, which is located on the south side of Northeast 18<sup>th</sup> Street at 164<sup>th</sup> Avenue in east Clark County. This 56-acre park now features a wide variety of outdoor recreation opportunities for both children and adults, including an off-leash dog park, walking and biking trails, a playground, basketball courts, and an Extreme Sports Park.



This 3-D design drawing shows Phase 1 of the Extreme Sports Park, which was built as part of the 2007-08 Pacific Community Park construction project.

There was a great deal of interest in building a 20,000 square foot Extreme Sports Park during the planning phase of the Pacific Community Park. However, Clark County only had enough funding to construct half of what was planned. We need your help taking this Extreme Sports Park to the next level!

## Extreme Sports Park: Phase 2

Clark County and Vancouver-Clark Parks and Recreation recognize the importance of expanding the Extreme Sports Park at Pacific Community Park from 10,000 to 20,000 square feet. The full-size facility will provide more space for both beginning and expert skateboarders, BMX riders and in-line skaters, and it will give them a wider variety of bowl and street-style surface options to explore.

Skateboarding is one of the fastest growing sports in the nation, and is a great way for children and adults to get exercise while having fun. BMX and in-line skating are also extremely popular, but are sometimes excluded from parks designated for skateboarding only. The new Extreme Sports Park at Pacific Community Park is an all-inclusive experience designed for a wide range of skill levels.

Expanding the Extreme Sports Park could also help make Clark County a stop on the national competitive skateboarding, BMX or in-line skating event circuit – especially with the completion of the new Extreme Sports Park in Battle Ground in May 2007. Competitors and fans attracted by these events would bring economic benefits to Clark County with them.

## How Much Money is Needed?

The current cost to construct Phase 2 of the Extreme Sports Park is approximately \$300,000.

A second, less expensive option is to build only the “street” section of the Phase 2 plan. This option would cost approximately \$195,000.
