We are pleased to announce that construction of **Tiger Tree Neighborhood Park** will begin in mid-June 2009. As construction gets under way, we would like to let you know about the schedule and related activities.

<b>WHO</b>	Clark County Public Works and Vancouver-Clark Parks and Recreation planned and designed this park development project. The county has awarded the construction contract to Paul Brothers, Inc. of Boring, OR.
<b>WHAT</b>	<p>Tiger Tree Neighborhood Park is located a few blocks north of Padden Parkway, between Northeast 145th and 149th avenues in the Sifton area. Once complete, this 6-acre park will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Forested walking trails</li><li>• Small irrigated open lawn play area</li><li>• Landscaping and benches</li><li>• Playground</li><li>• Picnic tables</li></ul>
<b>WHEN</b>	Construction will start in mid-June 2009 and is expected to be complete by late fall/winter 2009. The contractor may work Mondays through Saturdays from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. or extended hours if necessary.
<b>WHY</b>	In 2005, voters in the unincorporated urban area of Clark County approved the Greater Clark Parks District to provide maintenance and operations funding for 35 new parks. The county is now developing these parks, including Tiger Tree Neighborhood Park.
<b>CONSTRUCTION INFORMATION</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The park will be closed throughout construction to protect public safety.</li><li>• Construction equipment will be entering and exiting the work site from Northeast 149th Avenue. The contractor understands the importance of working and driving safely in this neighborhood. Residents should also be extra careful around the construction equipment.</li><li>• Neighbors should expect noise, vibration and dust during construction.</li></ul>

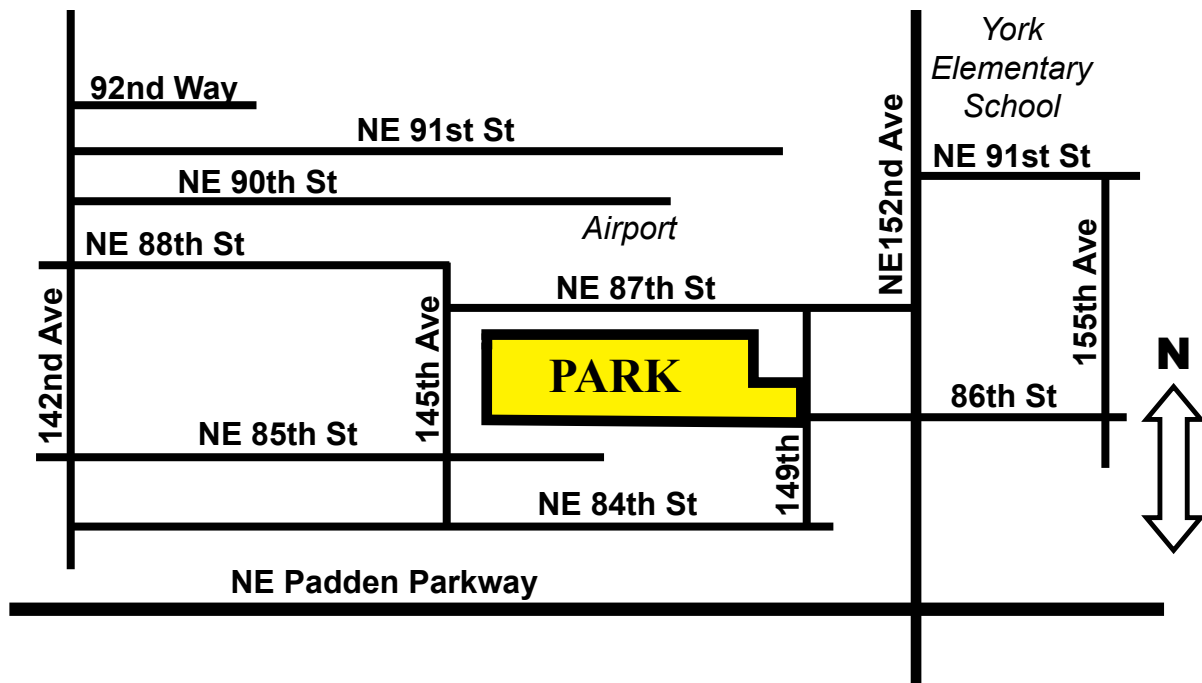
