Dog Park Moves to Pacific Community Park on July 7

The temporary dog park now located at Fisher-Mill Plain (Vandervort) Neighborhood Park will move to its permanent 8-acre home at Pacific Community Park beginning on July 1, 2008. Pacific Community Park is located on Northeast 172nd Avenue at 18th Street (see map on reverse).

Both dog parks will be open for one week to help with the transition. The temporary dog park at Vandervort Park will officially close on July 7, 2008. Off-leash use of the park will no longer be allowed after that date. Signs will be posted in the park explaining the change, and advising dog park users to go to Pacific Park instead.

The double gates at the entrances and the section of fence separating the temporary dog park from the general use area on the south side of the park will be removed immediately after the dog park closes. General public access and use of the park will continue after the dog park closes.

Later this fall, Clark County will reseed the grassy areas of the park. Public access to some areas may be restricted while they are being reseeded.

What's Next?

The potential to sell a portion of the Vandervort property to help reduce the cost of developing and maintaining the park and to help pay for park construction, is still being explored. Clark County will provide more information to neighbors later this summer.

Planning and design of the park will resume as soon as the size of the park is known. Clark County Public Works and Vancouver-Clark Parks and Recreation staff would like to thank residents for their participation and patience during this temporary park use.

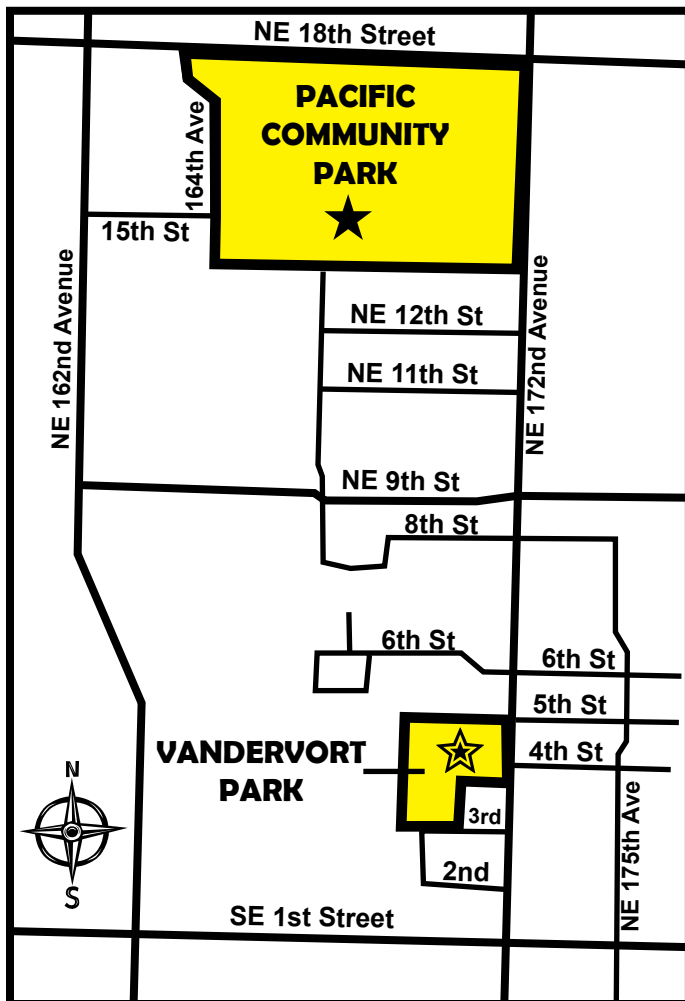
